Important

Mounting Instructions for Universal Push Mower Quick Release

Congratulations on your new purchase! You are just steps away from creating a beautifully patterned lawn using your new CheckMateTM lawn striping roller. To ensure a long life of both your mower and roller, please be sure to follow the mounting recommendations below.

Tools Required:



Step 1: Identify Installation Location (Anywhere on your handlebars, ideally as low (close to your frame) as possible:





Step 2: Prepare mounting location with silicon tape to insure a strong, snug install

Wrap the location on your handlebars where you plan to install your quick release with the provided silicon tape. (Shown Below) We recommend installing as low on your handlebars as possible, without impeding on any of your mower's functions.



Clamps Included:

"A" Handlebars Clamp Inserts: Fit standard Round handlebars. (Most brands)

"B" Handlebar Clamp Inserts: Fit larger diameter Round handlebars (Honda)

"C" Handlebar Clamp Inserts: Fit oversized Round handlebars: (Kobalt, Ryobi, Milwaukee, etc.) as well as Oblong oval handlebars (EGO)





Step 2: Install Quick Release

Once your mounting location is taped, you are ready to install your quick release.

Installation is quick and straight forward.

Identify the correct set of handlebar clamp inserts for your specific mower/handlebars.

Once identified, use the photos below as an installation guide. The install is the same for each type of clamp.

















Once the Clamps and Case are in place, begin tightening down. You want it to be snug and not able to pivot around the bar. Start by tightening the bottom bolt and then begin tightening the top bolt. Continue alternating until the case is completely tightened down.

Note: You can double up on the provided silicon tape should your mount be too loose.



Step 2: Assemble Mounting Arms


Using the schematic below, assemble your mounting arms in order to connect to the Quick Release in the next step.





Step 3: Install Mounting Arms

Align your mounting arm between the two clamps, insert the provided clevis pin. This is your quick release mechanism.





Step 4: Install Striping Kit

Remove preinstalled 1/2" x 1" bolts and lock washers from gray channel. Re-insert the bolt [with split lock washer] through the L shaped bracket and thread into the channel nut inside channel. (Before tightening bolts all the way down; center roller behind the mower)

After centering the roller; use a 3/4" wrench to firmly tighten each mounting arm to the striping roller.

Final Steps

Check installation, pick up the roller to confirm it freely pivots up and down.

Installation is now complete! Enjoy your striping with your new CheckMate ™ Striping kit!
